

ABSTRACT

Readiness refers to the overall condition of a person who makes him ready to give a response or answer in a certain way to a situation. This study aims to examine the characteristics of informants, 2) physical, mental, and emotional conditions, 3) needs, motives, and goals, 4) skills and knowledge, related to the readiness of ABH families at the stage of social reintegration at the Antasena Magelang Center. The method used in this study is qualitative method with descriptive approach. The source of data used in this study was determined by determining the source of purposive sample data. The data collection techniques used were: 1) in-depth interviews, 2) observation, and 3) documentation studies. The validity check technique uses tests of data credibility, transferability, confirmability, and dependability. Furthermore, the results of the study were analyzed with qualitative analysis techniques. The results showed that the readiness of ABH families still has problems, namely there is still stigma from the community, unmet basic needs for ABH, lack of skills related to parenting patterns, and knowledge of social reintegration that is poorly understood by ABH families. In connection with the problems faced by the ABH family, efforts are needed to help solve the problem. The proposed activity program is "ABH Family Capacity Building on Social Skills".
